### Lives Impacted in Fiscal Year 2014:

- \* 2,741 women and 462 men served at all three locations
- \* 768 positive pregnancy tests and options counseling
- \* 588 ultrasounds
- \* 662 Chose Life (almost 9 out of 10)
- \* 43 clients accepted Christ and 28 recommitted their lives to following Christ
- \* 1,700 parenting class sessions to equip moms and dads with the tools to become awesome dads and outstanding mothers
- \* 2,900 individuals received the message of abstinence and purity for building healthy relationships and futures
- \* 7,000 student connections through Campus Outreach, so no student needs to choose between their education and parenting
- \* 12 found healing through the Abortion Recovery Ministry

# *Miami Valley Women's Center*

## **Programs**

The Miami Valley Women's Center is a life-affirming organization that strengthens families by responding to their physical, emotional, spiritual and social needs regarding pregnancy-related concerns, abstinence education and post-abortion recovery. **All services are at no cost to the client.**

### **Abortion Recovery Ministry (ARM)**

One-on-one support offers hope, healing and restoration in a confidential and compassionate environment for those who have personally experienced or been affected by abortion. This ministry also seeks to provide awareness and education to the community about the reality of abortion and its aftereffects through networking with local schools, churches and area agencies.

### **Abstinence Education**

*Worth Waiting For* - Through the partnership of the Miami Valley Women's Center and Dayton Christian Schools, the Miami Valley's first peer abstinence program was formed in 1991. The program developed to health class presentations to middle and high school teens in the Dayton and surrounding area. The program encourages young people to save sex for marriage and experience the benefits of sexual purity – to *WAIT, THINK, and LIVE*.

### **Abstinence Education Mentoring Groups**

**G.I.F.T.** - *Giving Insight, Friendship, & Truth* - Our in-school mentoring program for eighth grade girls is offered at area schools. The value and uniqueness of each girl is stressed in an environment where they feel loved, accepted, and encouraged to choose abstinence.

**S.T.A.R.S.** - *Self Respect, Truth, Accountability, Responsibility, Success* - This after-school club for junior high girls in Xenia and Cedarville promotes abstinence, character development and healthy relationships.

### **Careline**

Crisis intervention and/or appointment scheduling is available 24 hours a day / 7 days a week.

### **Crisis Education**

Trained client advocates provide initial crisis intervention, factual education about fetal development, risks of abortion procedures and alternative options, needs assessment, and ongoing emotional support for women and their partners. Adoption is presented as a loving option.

### **D.R.E.A.M.** - *Dare to Realize Every Action Matters*

This ministry educates healthy relationship building to women by taking a holistic approach to sexuality: emotional, physical, social, intellectual, and spiritual. Young women are equipped to believe their pasts do not have to determine their futures.

### **Evangelism & Discipleship**

This ministry exists to introduce our clients to the unconditional love of the Savior, Jesus Christ. Specific outreach evangelism opportunities, such as the client retreat and the Christmas Adopt-A-Family are planned to bring women to the knowledge of Jesus, His precious gift of salvation, and His plan and purpose for their lives. Group Bible study (*Growing Moms*) and one-on-one discipleship relationships provide emotional support and an atmosphere of trust and love where women feel comfortable sharing their lives and their struggles. Through applying Biblical principles to everyday living, they learn how to develop God-honoring relationships in every aspect of their lives.

### **Journey of Hope**

Medical expertise and emotional support are available for parents of unborn babies who have been diagnosed with a fatal birth defect.

### **Making Outstanding Mothers (MOMs) & Earn As You Learn (EAYL)**

This ministry provides unique incentive programs designed to build relationships and encourage responsibility. Emphasis is placed on making good decisions, goal setting, parenting skills, and relationship issues.

### **Ministry to Men – Developing Awesome Dads (DADs)**

This ministry challenges men involved in crisis pregnancies to step forward and claim their responsibilities as providers and protectors. Through Dad's one-on-one mentoring, men are encouraged to become effective fathers by providing them with "tools" and instilling confidence; they are then able to take on the challenge and responsibility of fatherhood. Additionally, post-abortive support allows restoration of a man's relationship with God, himself, and others.

### **Medical Services**

*Pregnancy Testing* - The MVWC is licensed as a pregnancy testing lab by the State of Ohio under the Ohio Department of Health/CLIA.

*Limited Ultrasound* - This powerful tool for women and their partners allows them an opportunity to see the intricate development of their unborn child.

### **Silver Linings**

Small group support is available for women and families who have experienced a miscarriage, stillbirth, or infant death.
